

Are PVC-sheathed optical cables flame retardant



Article Overview

PVC-sheathed optical cables can be formulated with flame retardants, but they are generally less fire-safe than LSZH cables and may produce dense smoke and toxic gases when burned.

PVC Cable Characteristics

PVC (Polyvinyl Chloride) jackets are commonly used for indoor fiber optic cables due to their flexibility, resistance to oxidation, and ease of installation . While PVC can be formulated with flame-retardant additives to meet certain vertical-burn or UL ratings, it is not inherently flame-resistant. When exposed to fire, PVC jackets can produce dense black smoke and halogen-containing acidic gases, such as hydrochloric acid, which are hazardous to both people and equipment .

Flame Retardant vs. Fire Resistant

It is important to distinguish between flame-retardant and fire-resistant cables. Flame-retardant cables, including some PVC-sheathed types, are designed to resist the spread of fire along the cable but do not maintain circuit integrity during a fire. Fire-resistant cables, on the other hand, are engineered to continue functioning under fire conditions for a specified period . Standard PVC jackets typically fall into the flame-retardant category if treated, but they are less effective than LSZH or specialized flame-retardant polyethylene in minimizing smoke and toxic gas emissions
