Cable tray bending involves shaping trays to navigate corners or obstacles, while grinding ensures smooth edges and proper fit for safe cable installation.

Manual Bending Process

For smaller or custom bends, cable trays can be bent manually using tools such as a manual bender, press brake, or angle grinder. The general steps include:

- **Marking the Bend:** Determine the required angle (commonly 45° or 90°) and mark the tray's centerline and sides. Divide the curve into equal segments to maintain a smooth radius ().
- **Cutting Side Walls:** Cut triangular or rectangular sections on the tray's side walls to allow folding without deforming the tray.
- **Forming the Bend:** Gradually bend each segment using a manual bender or press brake, ensuring uniform curvature.
- **Rejoining Side Walls:** After bending, rejoin the cut sections using welding, bolting, or riveting to reinforce the tray.
- **Grinding:** Smooth any sharp edges or weld seams with an angle grinder to prevent cable damage and ensure safety ().
