1. Box Type and Material Electrical boxes installed in cable wells must be suitable for wet or damp environments. Typically, this means using cast metal boxes, nonmetallic pull boxes, or NEMA-rated enclosures designed for outdoor or underground use . Metal boxes should be grounded to maintain electrical continuity, while nonmetallic boxes must be listed for use with the type of conduit and fittings installed . 2. Conduit and Raceway Requirements Cable wells often require concrete-encased PVC Schedule 40 conduit or galvanized rigid steel conduit to protect wiring from physical damage and moisture . Conduits should be properly sleeved through walls, floors, or slabs to allow for expansion, contraction, and waterproofing considerations . 3. Accessibility and Code Compliance NEC Article 314 mandates that all splices and terminations must be enclosed in an approved box that remains accessible for inspection and maintenance . Even in cable wells, boxes must not be buried or obstructed in a way that prevents access. Covers should be secure and weatherproof to prevent water ingress. 4. Waterproofing and Environmental Protection In areas with potential water exposure, boxes should be waterproof or weatherproof, and any penetrations through slabs or walls should include clamping rings, riser sleeves, or pipe curb assemblies to maintain the integrity of waterproof membranes .
