

# Can yellow pigtails be connected

Yellow pigtails are connected by twisting the stripped ends of multiple wires together with a short lead wire and securing them with a wire nut, then attaching the lead to the device terminal.

A pigtail is a short wire used to connect multiple circuit wires to a single terminal or device without overcrowding the connection point. Yellow pigtails typically indicate a wire gauge of 12 AWG, suitable for 20-amp circuits in residential wiring. - **Turn Off Power:** Always shut off the circuit at the breaker panel to prevent electrical hazards.
- **Strip the Wires:** Remove about 3/4 inch of insulation from the ends of the wires to be connected, including the yellow pigtail.
- **Align and Twist:** Hold the stripped ends together and twist them clockwise using pliers until tightly bundled.
- **Install Wire Nut:** Place a UL-listed wire nut over the twisted wires and turn until secure. Gently tug to ensure stability.
- **Connect to Device:** Attach the free end of the yellow pigtail to the device terminal (screw or push-in connector), ensuring firm contact.
- **Restore Power:** Once all connections are insulated and secure, turn the breaker back on ....
