Understanding TX/RX Alignment

Fiber optic communication uses two fibers for duplex transmission: one for transmitting (TX) and one for receiving (RX). For successful data transfer, the TX port on one device must connect to the RX port on the other device, and vice versa. Misalignment (TX-to-TX or RX-to-RX) prevents communication, causing no connectivity, intermittent signals, or slow data transfer .

Maintaining Proper Polarity

Polarity ensures that the light signal travels correctly from TX to RX. In duplex fiber applications:

- A-B (Type B) patch cords are commonly used, providing a straight-through connection that crosses the fibers internally so TX connects to RX automatically .
- Fiber connectors like LC, SC, ST, or MTRJ have keys to maintain orientation and prevent rotation, ensuring correct TX/RX alignment .
- In high-density MTP/MPO systems, polarity rules (Methods A, B, C) manage multiple fibers to maintain proper TX/RX matching across the link .
