Copper Connectors

Copper connectors are widely used for short-distance data transmission and electrical connections. They transmit data using electrical pulses through copper wires, which makes them cost-effective, easy to install, and compatible with a wide range of network equipment . Copper cables can carry both data and electrical power, which is useful for applications like Power over Ethernet (PoE). However, copper is limited by bandwidth constraints, signal attenuation over long distances, and susceptibility to electromagnetic interference (EMI) . Maintenance is often required to prevent issues like corrosion or water ingress in underground installations .

Fiber Optic Connectors

Fiber optic connectors transmit data using light signals through glass or plastic fibers, enabling high-speed transmission over long distances without significant signal loss . They are immune to EMI, more secure against tapping, and capable of supporting Gigabit and multi-Gigabit speeds . Fiber connectors are ideal for high-bandwidth applications, long-distance communication, and environments with high electrical interference. However, they are generally more expensive and fragile, requiring careful handling and precise installation
