

Do cables running through cable trays need to be run through conduits



Article Overview

Cables running through cable trays generally do not need to be in conduits unless additional protection is required by code or environmental conditions.

General Guidelines

Tray cables, often labeled TC or TC-ER, are designed to withstand industrial environments and can be installed openly in listed cable trays without conduit, provided they are properly supported and protected from mechanical damage according to NEC Article 392 and Article 336 . TC-ER-rated cables can also be run in exposed areas outside the tray for short distances (up to 6 feet) without conduit, as long as they are secured and protected .

When Conduit Is Required

Conduit may be necessary in situations where tray cables need extra mechanical or environmental protection:

- High-risk areas: Locations with forklifts, vehicles, or heavy equipment that could crush or damage cables .
- Outdoor or underground installations: Standard tray cables must be in conduit if not rated for direct burial; conduit also protects against UV, moisture, and extreme weather .
- Hazardous or classified locations: Chemical plants, explosive atmospheres, or da...
