Code and Regulatory Requirements

Electrical codes universally require that all wiring entering boxes, cabinets, or fittings be protected from abrasion and that openings be effectively closed . All splices, taps, and connections must be contained within an approved enclosure, such as a junction box or device box, which must remain accessible for inspection and maintenance . Covers, bushings, or smooth entry points are required to prevent damage to conductors and ensure safety .
