

Fiber optic switch connected to splitter

A fiber optic switch can be connected to a fiber optic splitter to distribute a single optical signal from the switch to multiple endpoints in a Passive Optical Network (PON).

How the Connection Works

A fiber optic switch acts as a central point that manages and routes optical signals between multiple fibers. When connected to a fiber optic splitter, the switch sends a single optical signal into the splitter, which then divides the signal into multiple outputs to serve several devices or users simultaneously. This setup is common in Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) networks, where one fiber from the switch can serve dozens of homes using a splitter with ratios like 1×32 or 1×64.

Types of Fiber Optic Splitters

- Fused Biconical Taper (FBT) Splitters: These are made by fusing fibers together and are cost-effective for small-scale splits (e.g., 1×2, 1×4), .
- Planar Lightwave Circuit (PLC) Splitters: These use lithography on a silica substrate to create precise waveguides, ideal for larger splits (e.g., 1×16, 1×32, 1×64) with uniform signal distribution .

Key Considerations

- Split Ratio: Determines how the input signal is divided. Higher ratios (like 1×64) increase the number of outputs but also increase insertion loss, reducing signal strength at each output
