

How far should the low-voltage box be from the cable tray



Overview

Industry standards often recommend at least 300mm (12 inches) of spacing between power and control trays to minimize EMI. Separation isn't just an EMI precaution — it protects signaling, reduces rework, and ensures pathways meet inspection expectations across risers, plenums, and shared trays. The reorganized NEC (NFPA 70) Chapter 7 limited energy articles, paired with TIA-569-E pathway requirements, define how these. According to NEC Article 392. For the installation of single conductor cables sized 1/0 AWG to 4/0 AWG in industrial establishments, the NEC specifies the maximum allowable rung spacing for the cable.
