

How long does a single-mode fiber optic cable need to be spliced

Multimode fiber comes in OM1 (legacy), OM3, OM4, and OM5 (OM2 is obsolete) and supports much shorter distances. The table below highlights the maximum distances supported by each. In fiber-optic communication, a single-mode optical fiber, also known as fundamental- or mono-mode, is an optical fiber designed to carry only a single mode of light - the transverse mode.
