3. **Circuit Grouping:** Group circuits logically to prevent overloading. For instance, avoid placing a fridge and toaster oven on the same circuit. Home offices, kitchens, and entertainment areas often need multiple circuits due to high simultaneous usage.
4. **Future-Proofing:** Leave extra space in the distribution box for future expansion, such as solar panels, additional appliances, or smart home devices. A common recommendation is to add 20% more circuit spaces than currently needed.
5. **Compliance with Codes:** Follow local electrical codes (e.g., NEC or IEC) to ensure safety. Codes dictate minimum circuit requirements for specific areas, maximum lo...
