

How many households can be connected to a 24-core fiber optic cable



Article Overview

A 24-core fiber optic cable can typically connect 192 to 384 households using standard FTTH splitters.

Explanation

In residential Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) deployments, each fiber core can serve multiple households through PLC (Planar Lightwave Circuit) splitters. Common splitter ratios are 1:8 or 1:16, meaning one fiber can be split to serve 8 or 16 homes .

- 1:8 splitter: $24 \text{ cores} \times 8 \text{ households per core} = 192 \text{ households}$
- 1:16 splitter: $24 \text{ cores} \times 16 \text{ households per core} = 384 \text{ households}$ This range depends on network design, distance, and signal quality. Using higher splitter ratios increases the number of connected homes but may reduce signal strength, requiring careful planning and possibly optical amplification for longer distances .

Additional Considerations

- Redundancy and future-proofing: It is common to reserve some cores for backup or future expansion, so not all 24 cores may be actively used initially .
- Single-mode vs. multi-mode: Single-mode fibers are preferred for long-distance outdoor connections, while multi-mode fibers are more common for short-distance indoor or campus networks .
- Network topology: Star or tree topologies affect how many households each fiber...
