- Fiber cleaver for precise cutting of the fiber end
- Fusion splicer (preferred) or mechanical splice kit
- Isopropyl alcohol wipes for cleaning
- Protective sleeves for spliced fibers
- Pigtail and patch cords for connection to equipment...
