 - **Weight:** "206 LB/KFT" shows the weight of the cable per 1000 feet, which is important for installation considerations.
 - **Minimum Bend Radius:** This is crucial for installation to avoid damaging the fibers; for example, "MBD 27IN" indicates a minimum bend diameter of 27 inches.
 - **Pulling Tension:** "600LBF" indicates the maximum pulling tension the cable can withstand during installation.
