Common Causes of Weak Signals

- **Dirty or Contaminated Connectors:** Dust, dirt, oil, or moisture on connector end-faces can block light transmission, causing significant signal loss. About 15–50% of fiber optic issues are due to contamination, including dust from hands, clothing, or the environment .
- **Physical Damage to Cables:** Cuts, sharp bends, kinks, or crushed cables can increase attenuation and reduce signal strength. Exceeding the fiber's minimum bend radius allows light to escape, weakening the signal .
- **Hardware Failures:** Faulty transceivers, switches, routers, or media converters can cause intermittent connectivity or low signal levels. Indicator LEDs like “LOS” (Loss of Signal) can help identify these issues .
- **Environmental Factors:** Temperature extremes, moisture ingress, or improper installation can degrade signal quality over time .
- **Intrinsic Fiber Loss:** Even in perfect conditions, fibers experience some signal loss due to Rayleigh scattering and material absorption, which is accounted for in the network's loss budget .

- **Inspect and Clean Connectors:** Use lint-free wipes, isopropyl alcohol, and fiber ins...
