This allows for extremely high speeds, low latency, and minimal signal degradation over long distances, making fiber ideal for businesses with high data demands, real-time operations, or symmetrical upload and download requirements. Dedicated fiber lines are typically installed directly from the service provider's network to the customer's premises, ensuring exclusive access and consistent performance.

Electrical (Copper) Dedicated Lines

While fiber is the standard for modern dedicated lines, some leased lines can still use copper (electrical) cables, such as traditional DSL or T1 circuits. These copper-based lines transmit data electrically rather than optically and generally offer lower speeds and shorter maximum distances compared to fiber. Copper leased lines are less common today but may still be used in areas where fiber infrastructure is unavailable.
