Planning the Cable Route

For optical cables, ensure the route minimizes sharp bends and mechanical stress, as excessive bending can damage fibers. For electrical cables, consider voltage requirements, environmental conditions, and whether the installation is indoor or outdoor.

Selecting the Right Cable

- Electrical cables: Choose based on voltage, current capacity, insulation type, and environmental exposure (moisture, temperature, UV). Copper is commonly used for its conductivity, while aluminum may be used for cost-effective solutions.
- Optical cables: Select fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode), jacket type (indoor, outdoor, armored), and ensure the cable has a strength member like Kevlar to prevent stretching or breakage during pulling.
