

# **National standard for the distance of cross-road optical fiber cables from the ground how many meters**



## **Overview**

The basic pole distance is 50m, which can be adjusted to 60m according to the terrain of mountainous areas. For Optical Fibre Backbone Cable installations, a minimum 30.0 m of cable must be stored / coiled in C8 pits no greater than 1000 m apart for future installation requirements.
