- **Signal Loss and Distance:** Optical fibers experience attenuation measured in decibels (dB). When connecting to another network, consider the total distance and signal loss to ensure reliable communication.
- **Network Integration:** When integrating external fiber, verify that the wavelength, transmission power, and equipment compatibility align with your network to preven...
