Incremental Network Expansion: Over time, additional fibers are added, re-patched, or re-spliced without reorganizing the internal layout. This leads to tangled or overlapping cords as new connections are integrated into an already dense environment . **Inconsistent Routing Standards:** Different technicians or teams may follow varying routing practices, resulting in mixed paths for feeder fibers, distribution fibers, and jumpers. This lack of standardization increases congestion and crossing of cables . **Insufficient Management Space:** Many optical distribution boxes are not designed with adequate reserved space for future expansion. When fibers are forced into limited space, cords bend excessively, twist, or overlap, violating minimum bend radius requirements and causing micro-bending that degrades signal quality . **Frequent Handling and Reconfiguration:** Patch cords are more vulnerable than backbone cables because they are repeatedly connected, disconnected, and moved. This handling can lead to disorganized layouts, connector contamination, and accidental damage . **Lack of Functional Segmentation:** Mixing different types of fibers in the same routing layer—such as feeder, distribution, and jumper fibers—creates congestion and makes it difficult to maintain a logical structure. Proper functional separation reduces crossing, twisting, and accidental disturbance during maintenanc...
