

Regulations on the Use of Low-Voltage Distribution Boxes in Mexico



Article Overview

Low-voltage distribution boxes in Mexico must comply with NOM-003-SCFI-2014 and NOM-001-SEDE-2012, ensuring safety, proper installation, and certification for voltages up to 1,000 V AC and 1,500 V DC.

Applicable Standards

NOM-003-SCFI-2014 establishes safety requirements for electrical equipment, including low-voltage distribution boxes, to protect users from electrical shock, fire hazards, and other risks. It applies to devices using public service electricity, batteries, accumulators, or self-generation systems, covering both AC (up to 1,000 volts) and DC (up to 1,500 volts) applications . NOM-001-SEDE-2012 regulates the safety and efficiency of electrical installations, including grounding, bonding, and proper wiring practices for low-voltage systems . Compliance ensures that distribution boxes are installed according to safe design and operational standards.

Certification and Compliance

Low-voltage distribution boxes must be certified by an accredited Certification Body (CB) before being sold or installed in Mexico. The certification process involves testing for electrical safety, proper labeling, and adherence to applicable NOMs . Products must display the NOM mark according to NOM-106-SCFI-2017, which specifies label design, placement, and visibility . Importers, manufacturers, or distributors are responsible for ensuring compliance. This includes submitting samp...
