Splitters come in different types, such as Fused Biconical Taper (FBT) for small splits and Planar Lightwave Circuit (PLC) for larger, precise splits .

Fiber Optic Distribution Frames (ODFs)

An ODF is a centralized platform for managing, connecting, and protecting backbone optical cables. It provides termination, splicing, patching, and modular expansion for hundreds to thousands of fiber cores . ODFs are typically installed in central offices, data centers, or telecom rooms, and they help organize high-density networks while reducing the risk of fiber damage or signal loss .
