

Spacing between cable tray hanger supports



Article Overview

Cable tray supports should typically be spaced 1.5 to 3 meters apart for horizontal runs, with hangers not exceeding 1.5 meters, while vertical runs require supports at intervals of less than 2 meters.

Horizontal Cable Tray Runs

For straight horizontal sections, the support span between cable tray supports generally ranges from 1.5 meters to 3 meters, depending on the tray type, material, and cable load. This spacing ensures structural stability, prevents sagging, and allows for maintenance and inspection. At corners, bends, or T-junctions, it is recommended to install one hanger on each side, arranged symmetrically to maintain tray stability and prevent undue stress on the cables. Fixed supports should also be placed at the beginning and end of the tray and at beam locations to distribute weight effectively.

Vertical Cable Tray Runs

For vertical installations, supports should be fixed to the building structure at intervals preferably less than 2 meters. Cables within vertical trays should be secured at the top and then every 1.5 meters to maintain order and prevent displacement. Hanging rod supports for vertical runs should have a minimum diameter of 8 mm to ensure stability.
