

Spacing between two cables inside the cable tray

Proper spacing between cables in a cable tray is essential for safety, efficiency, and compliance with electrical standards.

Recommended Spacing Guidelines

- Horizontal Spacing:
 - When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, maintain a minimum distance of 0.6 meters between them. This spacing allows for maintenance, inspection, and proper airflow, which is crucial for heat dissipation .
 - For horizontal sections where cable trays are laid out in a straight line, the spacing typically ranges from 1.5 meters to 2 meters. This distance facilitates easy access and efficient maintenance .
- Vertical Spacing:
 - The minimum vertical clearance between cable trays should be 150 millimeters (approximately 6 inches). This clearance is necessary to prevent obstruction and ensure structural integrity .
 - If cables with a diameter of 50 mm or greater are installed, the vertical clearance should be increased to 300 mm .
- Spacing Between Power and Signal Cables:
 - The horizontal spacing between power and signal cable trays should generally not be less than 0.5 meters to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI) . If the trays are shielded, this spacing may be reduced to less than 0.3 meters
