

# Standard Requirements for Labeling Fiber Optic Distribution Boxes in Server Racks



## Article Overview

Fiber optic distribution boxes in server racks should be labeled according to ANSI/TIA-606-B or TIA-606-C standards, with clear identifiers for rack location, tray/module position, and port numbers, using durable, readable labels on both front and rear of the rack.

### Rack and Cabinet Identification

Each rack or cabinet must have a unique identifier based on its location within the data center grid. ANSI/TIA-606-B specifies using X (alpha) and Y (numeric) coordinates corresponding to floor tiles or row/cabinet positions, combined with a floor/space identifier (FS.XY) to create a unique label for each rack . Labels should be placed at the top and bottom on both the front and rear of the rack for easy identification .

### Fiber Optic Distribution Box Labeling

- **Housing/Chassis Labels:** The front door of the distribution box should have a locating crop mark for the ID label, and a removable label card inside the door can be used for moves, adds, and changes .
- **Tray and Module Labels:** Trays are typically pre-labeled (e.g., 01-12 from bottom to top), and modules within trays are labeled (e.g., A-D) to indicate position ....
