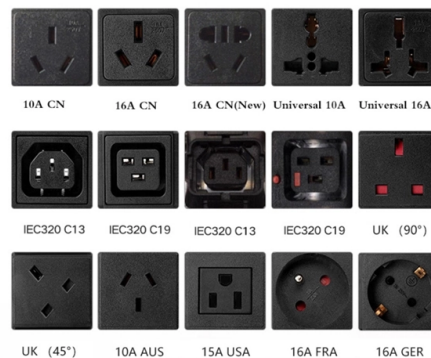


What are cold aisle server racks in a computer room

A cold aisle is a cooling strategy where the fronts of server racks face each other, creating a dedicated pathway for cool air from the cooling systems to flow directly into the equipment. This configuration minimizes the mixing of hot and cold air, ensuring consistent airflow and. Hot aisle and cold aisle containment are foundational concepts in data center design. When implemented correctly, they improve efficiency, reduce energy consumption, extend equipment life, and enhance overall reliability. This directs cold air from the cooling systems to the front of the servers and exhausts hot air out the back, keeping airflow.
