

What are the grounding requirements for optical cables in computer rooms



Overview

Article 645 of the 2017 Edition of the National Electrical Code (NEC) covers equipment, power supply wiring, equipment interconnecting wiring, and grounding (bonding) of information technology (IT) equipment and systems in IT equipment rooms. Fiber optic cable transmits data as light through glass or plastic strands, which means the fiber core itself carries no electrical current and requires no grounding. While nonarmored fiber optic cables don't require grounding due to their nonconductive properties, grounding is crucial when using armored fiber optic cables.
