

What are the requirements for cable tray ground installation



Article Overview

Ground-level cable tray installations must comply with NEC standards for cable type, fill capacity, grounding, separation, and accessibility to ensure safety and reliability.

Cable Types and Permitted Use

Only tray-rated cables (Type TC) or metal-clad cables (Type MC) are suitable for open-air cable tray installations on the ground. Single conductors smaller than 1/0 AWG are generally not permitted unless part of a multiconductor assembly or installed in a raceway within the tray. Cables must be rated for exposure to environmental conditions such as heat, moisture, and mechanical stress .

Tray Fill Capacity

The fill capacity of the tray must not exceed NEC limits to prevent overheating and maintain airflow. For power cables, the fill should not exceed 40% of the tray's cross-sectional area, and for control or communication cables, 50% is recommended. Best practice is to maintain 50% or less to allow for future expansion and proper cooling .

Grounding and Bonding

Metallic cable trays can serve as an Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC) if they meet NEC requirements. All tray sections must be electrically continuous and properly bonded at splice points. If mechanical connections do not ensure continuit...
