Overview

The Atari ST hard disk interface uses ACSI (Atari Computer System Interface), a simplified derivative of the SCSI protocol, to communicate with connected peripherals. This allows for the connection of up to 8 devices on the same port. Hard disk drives are accessed over one of a number of bus types, including parallel ATA (PATA, also called IDE or EIDE; described before the introduction of SATA as ATA), Serial ATA (SATA), SCSI, Serial Attached SCSI (SAS), and Fibre Channel. Bridge circuitry is sometimes used to connect hard disk. The ST-506 and ST-412 (sometimes written ST506 and ST412) were early hard disk drives introduced by Seagate in 1980 and 1981 respectively, that later became construed as hard disk drive interfaces: the ST-506 disk interface and the ST-412 disk interface. Introduced in 1980, the ST-506 was. When the Atari ST was launched, in 1985 hard disks were not much used - they were too expensive, exotic pieces of hardware. Standards were not established, and there was no IDE (ATA), later winner in mass storage system for masses :-). Atari added some support for the (future) connection of hard.
