

What is a gigabit optical port on a switch called

A gigabit optical port on a switch is a high-speed port that uses optical fiber and SFP modules to transmit data at 1 Gbps over long distances.

Overview

A gigabit optical port (also called a G port when referring to Gigabit Ethernet) is designed to handle 1 Gbps data transmission using optical fiber instead of traditional copper cables. Unlike standard RJ45 Ethernet ports, which use twisted-pair copper cables and are limited to about 100 meters, optical ports can transmit data over much longer distances, ranging from hundreds of meters to over 100 kilometers depending on the fiber type and module used .

How It Works

These ports typically use SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) transceiver modules, which are hot-swappable and modular. The SFP module inserted into the port determines whether the connection uses single-mode or multimode fiber, and whether it is a single-fiber (simplex) or dual-fiber (duplex) setup . The module converts electrical signals from the switch into optical signals for transmission over fiber and converts incoming optical signals back into electrical signals for the switch .
