

What is the appropriate galvanizing thickness for hot-dip galvanized cable trays



Article Overview

Hot-dip galvanized cable trays typically require a minimum zinc coating thickness of $45\mu\text{m}$ for standard tray components, with heavier components requiring $55\mu\text{m}$ or more.

Standard Requirements

For hot-dip galvanized (HDG) cable trays, the minimum zinc coating thickness is primarily determined by the steel thickness and component type. According to industry standards:

- Tray side and base plates (1.5–3mm thick): Minimum local zinc thickness of $45\mu\text{m}$, corresponding to a coating mass of at least 325 g/m^2 .
- Heavier components (brackets, supports >3mm thick): Minimum zinc thickness of $55\mu\text{m}$.
- Local thickness: Measured at multiple points on the surface using a magnetic thickness gauge; all points must meet the minimum requirement.
- Mean coating mass: Represents the average zinc mass per unit area of the entire workpiece, typically verified by gravimetric methods.
