The fiber optic cable for a router is typically a thin, yellow cable with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors, designed to connect to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) rather than directly to most consumer routers.

Characteristics of Fiber Optic Cables

Fiber optic cables transmit data using light rather than electrical signals, which allows for higher speeds and longer distances without interference . Residential fiber installations usually use single-mode fiber cables with SC/APC connectors, which are green-tipped and designed for precise light transmission . These cables are often thin and yellow, distinguishing them from standard Ethernet cables .

How Fiber Connects to Your Network

- **Fiber to ONT:** The fiber optic cable from your ISP enters your home and connects to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT). The ONT converts the light signals into electrical signals compatible with standard networking equipment .
- **ONT to Router:** From the ONT, a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher) connects to your router's WAN port. This step is necessary because most consumer routers do not have a direct fiber input .
- **Direct Fiber Input:** Only routers with an SFP or SFP+ port designed for fiber can accept a fiber optic cable directly. Even then, the correct module must match your ISP's protocol (e.g., GPON or XGPON) to function properly
