

What is the leakage current of the primary distribution box



Overview

(1) The rated leakage action current of the leakage protector in the main distribution box shall be 50-100ma, and the rated leakage action time shall be greater than 0. And it has the function of overload short circuit protection. This is usually called leakage current. However, the definition of the term does not contain. Leakage current refers to unintended electrical current that flows through an insulation path, protective earth, or surrounding environment instead of the intended circuit conductor. This phenomenon occurs even when electrical equipment is operating normally and does not always indicate immediate. A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices.
