

What to do if the fiber optic cable is blocked by the panel

If a fiber optic cable is blocked or obstructed by a panel, carefully reroute the cable to maintain proper bend radius and avoid damage, ensuring signal integrity and long-term network reliability.

Immediate Steps

- **Inspect the Panel and Cable** Check the patch panel or cable management tray for tight bends, tangles, or overcrowding. Identify the exact point where the cable is blocked or pinched, as excessive bending can cause attenuation or permanent fiber damage .
- **Maintain Minimum Bend Radius** Ensure that the fiber cable is not bent beyond its minimum bend radius. Exceeding this radius can lead to signal loss and long-term degradation . Use bend radius protectors or cable guides if necessary.
- **Reroute the Cable** Gently move the cable to a clear path within the panel or tray. Avoid sharp turns, kinks, or overlapping fibers. If the panel is overcrowded, consider reorganizing or adding additional cable management accessories to prevent future blockages .
- **Check Connectors and Ports** Inspect connectors for dirt, scratches, or misalignment. Clean them with a fiber optic cleaning kit if needed. Ensure that transmit (Tx) and receive (Rx) fibers are correctly connected and that polarity is maintained .
- **Test Signal Integrity** After rerouting, test the fiber link using a power meter or OTDR to confirm that signal loss is within acceptable limits. Values outside the normal range may indicate microbends or stress on the fiber
