How to Recognize the Fiber Optic Cable

- **Appearance:** Fiber optic cables are usually thin, flexible, and often yellow, though other colors exist. They are made of glass or plastic fibers that transmit data as light pulses, unlike Ethernet cables that carry electrical signals .

- **Optical Network Terminal (ONT):** The fiber cable from your ISP terminates at the ONT, which converts the light signals into electrical signals that your router can use .
- **Router Connection:** After the ONT, a standard Ethernet cable connects the ONT to your router's WAN port. The fiber cable itself does not plug directly into most consumer routers .
- **Combo Units:** In some setups, the ONT and router are combined into a single device, in which case the fiber cable connects to the integrated optical port .
