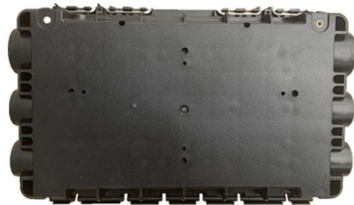


Will fiber optic and pigtail tests turn red
